

The Croatian Language Spring School offers students a one or two week programme of Croatian Language training.

Students are split into groups per week with a dedicated language teacher for each group and with no more than 7 students per class. The programme caters to students of Beginner to Advanced language levels.

Arriving on Saturday or Sunday, students will settle into their accommodation on the island and meet their teachers and fellow students at their leisure. On Sunday students are invited to attend a welcoming reception.

Tuition will take place Monday to Friday for 5 hours per day, a total of 25 hours per course. Beginning each day at 09.00, the morning classes last 3 hours and the focus is on all four language skills, learning grammar and performing language exercises. In the afternoon, classes start at 16.00 and there is one hour of speaking practice followed by one hour of writing exercises.

Information on Tutors and Teaching Methods

Language Tutors: All our teachers are native Croatian speakers with university degree qualifications and are specialists in teaching the Croatian language and giving cultural briefings to non-Croatians.

Method: Using creative methods we develop all four language skills - reading, writing, listening and speaking using authentic teaching materials and techniques such as role play and grammar exercises to reinforce each lesson's objectives. For advanced level students we review current affairs via newspapers & journals in order to augment the student's knowledge of the culture and provoke discussion.

Levels: Beginner | Intermediate | Advanced

Levels: What can I expect to achieve?
<p>Beginner: I will be able to express & understand simple conversations about myself, my family & daily life; to make simple sentences in the present tense & understand simple questions concerning my family, where I live and the friends & people around me; to read simple texts set out in a standard sentence structure.</p>
<p>Intermediate: I will be able to converse simply using past & future tenses; to converse with a Croatian person speaking slowly on topics where I know the vocabulary; to give my opinions on cultural & abstract issues; to ask & advise on issues relating to travel & leisure activities.</p>
<p>Advanced: I will be able to read and understand routine magazine articles & understand more complex issues which are both familiar & unfamiliar to me; to speak articulately and descriptively on topics relating to my personal interests and life.</p>

Course Dates

The Croatian Language Spring School 2012 will be held from Saturday 31st March until Saturday 14th April. Each weekly stay runs from Saturday to Saturday with tuition Monday to Friday.

There is the option to enrol on either a 1 week or a 2 week course:-

1 week course starts Saturday 31st March or 7th April

2 week course starts Saturday 31st March
