Students need to be available from 8.00 until 20.00hr GMT and have access to Skype. Lessons can take place from home or office and from any global location. Skype gives students the opportunity to consolidate class training or the opportunity to start learning the language when class meetings are not a viable option. About our courses

Skype tutorials can take place 7 days a week between 8am to 8pm GMT. Each lesson is on a personal one to one basis with a native Croatian teacher and lasts 45 minutes. Students start with a minimum of 10 lessons.

Weekend courses in Zagreb offer students a total of 10 hours language tuition. Tuition is available on a one to one or maximum of 2 students basis and the tutor is a native Croatian. Centrally located, students are also taken on cultural tours of the city between classes and are also offered the opportunity to attend a cultural event. Departing for Zagreb from London with a choice of 3 airports (Heathrow; Luton; or Gatwick) on Friday evenings and returning to London on Monday mornings, students have a full schedule for the weekend in this dynamic capital city.
